

## BOGOTA – SALT CATHEDRAL AND GUATAVITA LAKE

### Highlights

- Laguna de Guatavita – Get close to the Eldorado myth
- Salt Cathedral in Zipaquirá – A church within the mountain



After driving to the lake of Guatavita you begin the short hike to the legacy of the legendary Eldorado. After a 30 minutes' walk through a little forest and typical highland vegetation you will reach the crater border at 3000m above sea level. Enjoy the nice view on the Crater Lake, where once coronation ceremonies of the Muisca tribe's princess took place. Immerse yourself in the stories of the coronation day and imagine the goldrush of the European conquistadores trying to find the supposedly huge treasures.

In Zipaquirá, a small city located approx. 1 hour north from Bogotá you will visit the Salt Cathedral. Marvel at the imposing underground cathedral. It is a complete church built inside a former salt mine. Learn more about the religious significance of the place and the importance of the salt for the region and its history.
